<b>Transport – being struck by moving vehicles.</b>	Workers and others may suffer injury if struck by a moving vehicle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Workers are aware of relevant safety issues</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>LONEALERT Instant device</li> </ul>
